Epilepsy Society of Australia Clinical Epileptology Observerships

The ESA is offering clinical epilepsy training observerships of 3 months duration for early career clinicians from the Asian-Oceanian Region. A number of host institutions are available throughout Australia, and can offer clinical experience (as an observer), and/or training in investigational aspects of epilepsy (e.g. EEG).

Academic backing from the applicant's own institution is required.

The candidate should be committed to the care of patients with epilepsy, preferably in the setting of a public hospital.

Criteria for application:

- Not in training and within 5 years of completing local Neurology training
- Candidate must have academic support from home institution.
- Candidate must be supported by the ILAE Chapter member in country of origin.
- Candidate must be proficient in conversational English language with an assessment of English proficiency required.

Application process:

All applications should include the following:

- Candidates should outline their clinical epileptology/EEG training goals.
- Curriculum vitae including the names of two referees
- Supporting letter from supervisor at home institution
- Supporting letter from local president of ILAE chapter

Applications should be made at least by November 30 of the year prior to taking up the fellowship

Funding:

Stipend of up to and not more than \$10,000, to cover airfare, accommodation and living expenses in Australia.

With potential for top-up funding from ASEPA. Reimbursement of costs to applicant.
